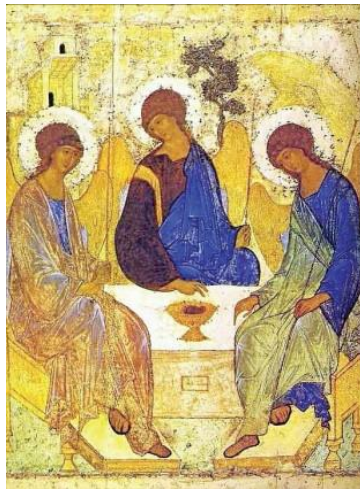
A Visit with Bishop Linda
